Family Day at Taichung City

Hands-on activities teach Asian history, culture

WHAT:

The Institute of Texan Cultures presents a day of family friendly activities exploring the Asian cultures that have influenced the island of Taiwan and contributed to the Taichung City Da Dun Cultural Exchange Exhibition.

Activities include Chinese-style Gu Zheng music, a lesson on the 12 animals of the Chinese Zodiac and a game of Jianzi -- Chinese-style hacky sack; a Taiwanese dance performance; Japanese cultural activities, including making a paper Kabuto warrior hat and Uchiwa paper fan; and demonstrations of Korean culture, including a food sampling, money counting in Korean and a dance performance.

The institute is hosting the Taichung City Da Dun Cultural Exchange Exhibition, which displays 110 prize-winning Taiwanese artworks in sculpture, watercolor painting, oil painting, seal engraving and other techniques.

Family Day at Taichung City is a great preview of what's to come at the Asian Festival in February.
